Dr. Idit Harel is an award-winning pioneer in inventing technology for cultivating creative learning, innovation, and globalization through constructionist learning. An Israeli-American entrepreneur, she founded Globaloria to provide STEM and computing courses to schools worldwide to prepare youth for the global knowledge economy. Idit is a published author and speaker worldwide, and has been serving on Advisory Boards and Committees at the MIT Media Lab, Harvard Graduate School of Education, CUNY Macaulay Honors College, Colorado University's ATLAS Institute, and PBSKids Next Generation Media. Idit holds degrees from Tel Aviv University (BA, 1982), Harvard University (HGSE EdM; CAS 1985), and MIT Media Lab (PhD, 1988).



Jennifer W. Lopez is the Commercial Innovation Technology Development Lead at the Center for the Advancement of Science in Space (CASIS). She is developing commercial R&D and breakthrough innovations for the International Space Station. As the Founding Member of NASA's Datanaut Corps in the Office of the Chief Information Officer (OCIO), Jennifer is inspiring future engineers, data scientists, and entrepreneurs who share a passion for learning and exploration to engage with NASA's open data from NASA missions, answering challenges in technology, aeronautics, the space station, the solar system, Earth, and NASA's Journey to Mars. Jennifer holds a BS from the University of Texas in Austin, and graduate degrees from Harvard and MIT.



Robert Scott is a Principal at the Texas Star Alliance, an expert in education policy who provides strategic counsel to state and national clients on education issues. He served as the Texas Commissioner of Education (2007-2012) and was confirmed unanimously by the Texas Senate in 2009 and 2011. As Commissioner he served as the head of the Texas Education Agency, which oversees the state's 1200 school districts and charter schools. He has also served as an assistant to two previous Commissioners of Education and as a legislative advisor to the Texas State Senate and United States House of Representatives. He had been primarily focused on public and higher education. Robert holds a BA and a JD from the University of Texas School of Law.
